  - On grounds of Health & Safety all animals except for Guide and Assistance Dogs must remain outside the building.


#### Remember

#### **Joining the Library**

- It is free to join Cavan County Council's Library Service. You can apply in person in your local library or online at www.cavanlibrary.ie
- You must show photographic identification (ie. Driving Licence) and proof of current address (i.e. Utility Bill / Bank Statement) to join.
- Children and young people under the age of eighteen years must get permission from a parent/guardian to join the library. A parent/ guardian must provide identification as above to activate a child's membership.
- Students who are not permanently resident in Co. Cavan and are not members of their local Library must show photographic identification and provide a guarantor's proof of address to activate membership.
- Cavan Library members can use their membership card to borrow items in any public library in the Republic of Ireland.
- Remember to bring your library card with you when you visit the library. If you forget your card, you will be asked for some form of identification
- Beware of lending your library card to anyone as you are responsible for items borrowed on it. Please report lost library cards immediately.
- Let us know if you change your address, phone number or email address.
- You choose a PIN number when you join the library. Using your library membership number and your PIN number you can login to your online library account and access a wide of online library services. You can change your PIN number online at: www.cavanlibrary.ie
- o Do not share your PIN with anyone else.

#### **Membership & Borrowing**

- Members can borrow up to 12 items including DVDs for a period of three weeks.
- All members have access to the Library Catalogue online at www.cavanlibrary.ie and can search catalogue and reserve up to 12 items.

#### **Renewing & Reminders**

- Please return your books on time to allow other library members to enjoy our collection.
- You can renew items online by logging in to your account at www.cavanlibrary.ie. You can also renew by telephone or in a library branch.
- Register your email address to receive an email reminder to return your items. Register your mobile phone number to receive a SMS text when your items are overdue. To 'opt in' to these services login to your online library account.
- Library membership, borrowing and access to online services will be blocked when you have overdue items after a certain period.
- You must pay the replacement cost of items that are lost or damaged.

#### **Photocopying and Printing**

- You can photocopy from library stock, subject to copyright restrictions.
- Self-Service Printing, Scanning & Photocopying is available in Cavan, Cootehill, Virginia & Bailieborough libraries. B&W - €0.20 Colour - €0.60
- Check with our other libraries to find out about their printing/photocopying service.

#### **Computers and Wi-Fi**

- You must be a registered member of the library to use computer and free Wi-Fi facilities. You will need your library card and PIN number to access these services.
- Computer sessions are available for a maximum of 55 minutes per day. You can book a session in advance.
